

## From the District 46 Handbook

**The General Service Representative** (GSR) has the job of linking their homegroup with AA as a whole and is responsible for carrying information to their group and generally representing their group's conscience at District and Area functions. The GSR also brings information regarding service opportunities to the group. The GSR attends District meetings, and the Western Washington Area Assembly to vote their group's conscience.
